

Minnesota Department of Human Services 2024 Live Well at Home RFP Open

Due date: Friday | April 7, 2023 | 4:00 pm Central Time

Through the Live Well at Home Grant request for proposal (RFP), Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) is seeking proposals to develop and/or provide services for older Minnesotans to live in the community of their choice, by improving their community's capacity to develop home and community-based services.

- The term of any resulting contract is anticipated to be 12 months, from July 1, 2023 until June 30, 2024, with the option to potentially extend beyond that date. The maximum initial award per year is \$350,000.
- There is a dollar-for-dollar or 50 percent project total matching requirement for all grant funds expended.
- Completed proposals are due in the DHS online application portal by 4:00 PM CT on Friday April 7, 2023.
