Preadmission screening & resource coordination *for nursing home providers*



A qualified health care professional must complete a preadmission screening (PAS) prior to admission to any Medicaid-certified nursing facility.

This presentation is for professionals who work in a nursing facility and want to learn more about how Minnesota Aging Pathways's PAS and level of care 90-day redetermination processes work, including how and when to submit a referral to Minnesota Aging Pathways.

Minnesota Aging Pathways can also provide resource coordination to help older adults return to a community setting after a nursing home stay.
